Money prizes: The total planned prize fund of the tournament is planned to be 500 EUR. It is guaranteed in

case if at least 50 participants take part in the tournament. The first prize is guaranteed to be 100 EUR. 6 general prizes and special prizes for best woman (in case of at least 3 women taking part), junior (born in 2001 and later) and senior (born in 1959 and earlier) players are planned.

Prizes are not shared and each participant can receive only one prize.

Late arrival and byes: Waiting time in case of late arrival is 15 minutes. If a player cannot take part in one of the first 3

rounds due to objective reasons, he/she can get a half point bye. The participant has to inform chief arbiter that he/she needs a bye and explain the reason before the end of the previous

round.
