

CSIT Rapid & Blitz Chess Championships for Workers and Amateurs, Pajulahti, Finland July 24-28, 2022 – Official Invitation



CSIT (the International Workers and Amateurs Sports Confederation) and TUL (the Finnish Workers' Sports Federation) are organizing the CSIT annual chess championships (Rapid & Blitz) from 24 July (arrival day) to 28 July (departure day) 2022, in Pajulahti Sports Institute, a sports and leisure center situated in the municipality of Nastola, Finland (about 1.5 hours' drive away from Helsinki).

Both Championships will be held according to the Swiss System with nine rounds. The time control of the Rapid one will be 25 minutes for each player + 10 seconds per move, while that of the Blitz will be 5 minutes for each player + 3 seconds per move.

All players who have FIDE ID can take part in the championships provided that their FIDE rating (Rapid or Blitz, respectively) does not exceed 2350.

In addition to the championships there will be a simultaneous exhibition for players whose FIDE Standard rating does not exceed 2000.

Simultaneously with the chess championships, CSIT championships in tennis and wrestling will be held at the same place and on the same dates

All the players will receive a certificate of participation. The 3 best ranked players, the most surprising player and the best players among the seniors (55+) of each championship and those who will excel in the simultaneous game will be awarded with medals.
